

Spring 2016: Courses offered in English

Exchanges students should take at least 6 credits and can take up to 20 credits for a regular semester. 1 credit meets 15 class hours per semester (1 hour per week).

Beginning Korean Language(01386-01) with Practical Korean Beginning(01391-02): CANNOT

However, for those who register Intermediate Korean Language (01388-02) cannot register Practical Korean: Intermediate (01393-01)

Please be sure that Intermediate Korean Language (01388-02) is lower level than (01388-01).
